- A. Approval of Agenda Motion to accept by Scott, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Luc. Motion carried.
- B. <u>Approval of last meetings Minutes</u> Motion to accept by Ken, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott. Motion carried.
- C. <u>Finance report</u> With the closing of our season, the following is the year to date figures as of October 31<sup>st</sup>. Gross Profit Golf Operations & Pro Shop, \$456,707.00, up \$17,987.00 from 2022. Bar/Kitchen \$111,445.00, up \$4,195.00 from 2022. Total Expenses, \$505,482.00, up \$72,824.00 from 2022. With current liabilities and estimated expenses the checkbook balance as of January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 is estimated to be \$37,391.00. Motion to accept finance report by Jesse, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Larry. Motion carried.
- D. <u>Grounds report</u> Rob The course is closed up and ready for winter. The guy from the irrigation shutdown suggested we consider looking into another pump, then we would have a backup if anything would happen to the current one which has a lot of hours on it. Water is very important for our course. The new tractor will be delivered next Wednesday. We should be looking at updating the current greens mower. After discussion, Ken made a motion to order the new greens mower at the estimate cost of \$53,563.74, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom. Motion carried. The estimate comes with a no fee cancellation policy. Rob will put together a priority list of future equipment needs. Motion to accept the grounds report by Luc, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott. Motion carried.
- E. <u>Manager report</u> Vicki The walk in cooler replacement is expected to take 3 more weeks but it has begun. Effective 01-01-2024, we will begin charging a 3% fee for all payments paid with a credit card. There will be no fee for the use of checks or debit cards. Discussion on cart storage rental fees was held. Due to increases in electric fees and insurance premiums there will be an increase in the cart storage rental fee agreement of \$10.00 per year for the next 5 years. After negotiation the cost of our trash and recycling has been reduced. A notice was received from the Town assessor, there has been a new rule pertaining to personal property taxes that will affect our club. It will be on the agenda for the town meeting on December 5<sup>th</sup> and some of our board members will be attending. Motion to accept Manager's report by Luc, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott. Motion carried.
- F. <u>Old Business</u> It was decided not to add the option for membership with a cart included. The bathroom project by #6 tee was completed and will continue with entry area upgrades next season. After much discussion it was decided to table the idea of back nine renovations.
- G. New Business We need to get estimates for floor covering replacement in the bar and possibly the dining & pro shop areas. We have \$6000 from our fundraiser to put towards it.
